

THE LINCOLN HERITAGE TOUR Ride to New Albany

You must have made arrangements for your own sag back to Evansville!!!! There is no return sag!!! The ride starts at Plaza Park middle School. Enjoy the ride!

- Right onto Lincoln Avenue
- Right onto Martin
- Left onto Newburgh Road
- Right onto Fuquay
- Left onto Newburgh Road
- Left onto State Street (Highway 261)
- Right onto Sharon Road (**possible stop at Circle S – approx. 7 mile mark**)
- Left onto Anderson Road
- Right onto Vann Road
- Left onto the Alcoa Highway (Highway 61)
- Right onto Roeder Road
- Left onto Yankeetown Road
- Right (East) onto Highway 62 (Main Street) in Boonville
(**possible stop at Pantry south of Boonville – approx. 21 mile mark**)
- Continue on 62 East
- Left (continuing on 62 East) at Lincoln Truck Stop
(**possible stop at Lincoln Truck Stop – approx. 33 mile mark**)
- Right on 162 in Gentryville
- Left onto 300E at Lincoln Boyhood Memorial
- Left (at T in road) onto 1625N at Lincoln City
- Right (East) onto 62 into Dale
(**possible stops at Pantry and Wendals in Dale- approx. 42 mile mark**)
- Continue East on 62 to St. Meinrad, Leavenworth and Corydon
(**possible stops at St. Meinrad [approx. 55 miles] and Possum Junction [approx. 68 miles]**)
- THE STRETCH FROM POSSUM JUNCTION TO THE OVERLOOK IN LEAVENWORTH IS ONLY ABOUT 20 MILES, BUT IT IS A GRUELING 20 MILE STRETCH! YOU SHOULD HAVE PLENTY OF WATER FOR THIS STRETCH AND SAGS SHOULD BE AWARE OF THEIR RIDERS ON THIS STRETCH!!!!**
- (**the Overlook in Leavenworth at approx. 85 miles is a great place to eat lunch!!!**)
- Continue on 62 East through Corydon and Lanesville
- Right onto Old Corydon Pike just before reaching I-64 at approx. 116 mile mark
WHILE DESCENDING INTO NEW ALBANY ON OLD CORYDON PIKE BEWARE OF A SERIES OF MEAN SWITCHBACKS AND SOME RAIL ROAD TRACKS THAT CROSS THE ROAD AT STEEP ANGLES!!!
- Left onto Main Street at stop sign (Also called River Road or Highway 111)
- Left onto Vincennes Street in New Albany (approx. 122 mile mark)
- Right into the White Castle for some post-ride sliders (on right side of street at approx. 123 miles)

SAG DRIVERS: You are responsible for keeping track of the riders you are sagging. If one of your riders does not reach the point where you are waiting within a time frame that seems reasonable **GO BACK AND CHECK ON THEM!!!** If a sag driver is going directly to the White Castle (not following the riders along the route) they can take I-64 to exit 118 (62-64 West Georgetown) and turn left onto Old Corydon Pike and then follow the sheet above to the White Castle.
