## Riders Under 18

Riders under 18 may participate in the Great Pumpkin Metric only if accompanied by a cycling parent or responsible adult. Riders under 18 need the approving signature of a parent on the application.

## Route and SAG Support

All three routes include well marked turns, maps, cue sheets, food and drink at rest stops and SAG support. SAG support will contain minimal tools to assist in minor bicycle repairs only. All riders should be prepared to make their own repairs. SAG support will be off the road at 4:00 p.m. Please plan accordingly to be off the route by 4:00 p.m.! You will be on your own after that, or if you leave the route.

## Rest Stops and Free Post-Ride Pasta Lunch

Once again, our rest stops will feature our legendary theme based amusement. Registration includes spectacular spaghetti, Rally's wonderfully seasoned chili, and Italian bread at the 4-H Center from noon until 4:00 p.m. Come and enjoy this post ride treat to live entertainment.

## Team Touring Competition

Once again the Great Pumpkin Metric will offer the popular "Team Touring" option for those who would like to participate as a group. To qualify, a "Team" must:

- Each team must consist of 5 or more cyclists
- Riders should register as a Team at the registration table prior to starting the ride.

Team members need not ride together after the start. Teams can be made up of any group with a common interest, i.e. company, family, church, neighborhood, etc. Each member may choose the ride distance he/she wishes. Each Team will receive a beautiful plaque denoting the number of riders and total mileage achieved. It's a fun way to ride with friends, build togetherness, promote your group and increase fitness awareness.

## GPM Raffle

**Pre-registered riders** will be eligible for prizes to be raffled at the 4H Center event headquarters. The drawing will be held at 10:15 a.m. and the winners will be posted at the 4H Center Swine Barn. You do not need to be present to win, but you must be a pre-registered rider for eligibility.

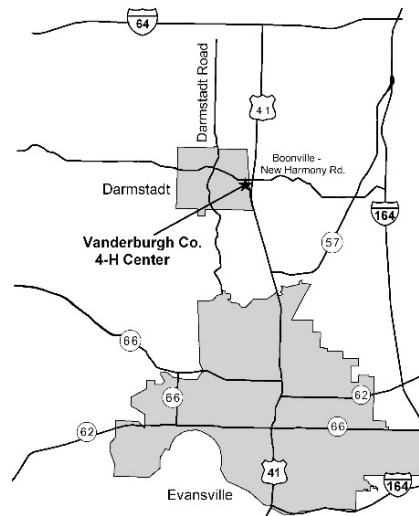
## Location
