*(Editor's Note: This information should have been in the newsletter months ago. Crazy deadlines and schedules placed it on the "I forgot" list. Here it is about two months late.)*

I thought I'd give you the good news...I made it, I crossed the finish line!! I made it in 15 hours and 5 minutes. That is 25 minutes faster than my Estimated Time of Arrival. I actually placed 7th in my age group. Icing on the cake!

I swam well (felt great); rode 112 hilly, hot (95 degrees) and WINDY miles, averaging 16.0 mph (no drafting or you go to the "sin bin" for 4 min...yikes!!); then I ran my first ever full marathon of 26.2 miles in 6 hours and 18 minutes I raced with a steadfast focus, never got negative, just made every move (every stroke, every pedal, and every step) count toward moving FORWARD and closer to that finish line!

My family and friends were there to watch me race at the transition point in La Grange, KY where the bike portion goes through twice at Mile 38 and Mile 68, as well as the finish. Having their cheers, waves and support made me want to race my best! I made them all these cool orange shirts, so they were easy to spot!!

Just thought you & EBC might want to know, they know have an Ironman in the club! ;-)

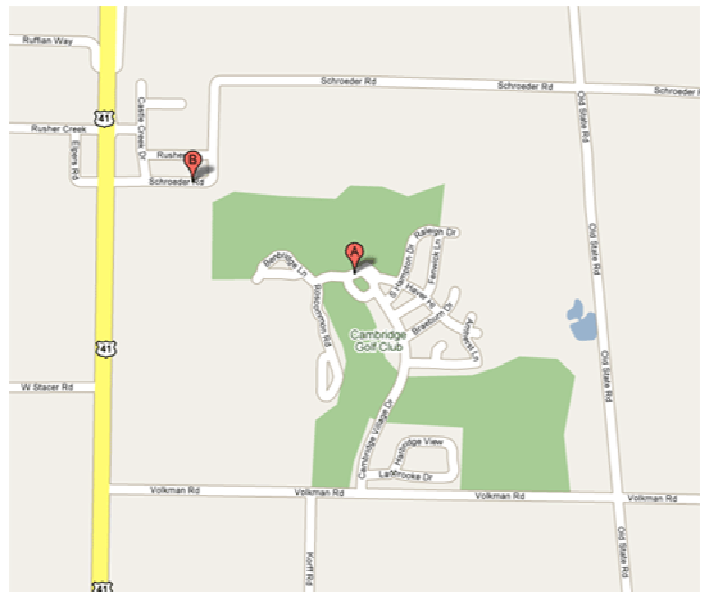

From Evansville North on US 41.

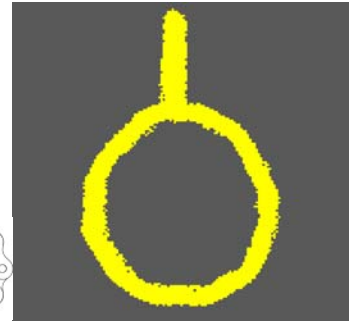
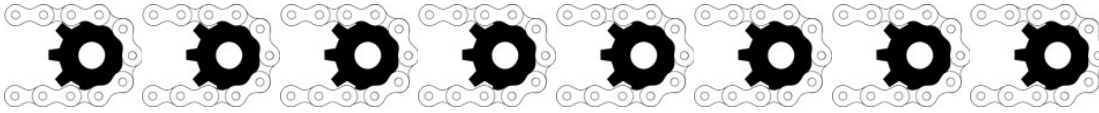
Right on Volkman Road.

**Hosted Rides:** Darlene and Jane are hosting the Infamy Day ride on December the 7th at 11AM starting at the Old Dam. I'm sure it will be a good event but you will probably have to bundle up!

**December Ride Schedule:** If you saw the draft for December, you probably didn't notice there was no ride listed for Christmas Day. I say that because nobody pointed it out to me. I noticed it and added a ride starting at Castle HS at 1PM. It was about halfway out of the Sunday morning rotation and a good place to start.

**Another Year Gone:** December brings another year to an end. For me, this will be the least club miles I've ever had, but it makes the year where I just missed 1000 miles seem like a really good year. At least I passed the 500 mile mark. I used to do that in one month, but things are different now. I can thank Mary Williams for most of those miles. She helps keep me motivated and checks to make sure I'm going to ride on the weekend. My work schedule all but prevents riding during the week. With the economy the way it is, I'm not going to complain!

I've had a busy year while mostly off the bike. I started the new EBC website and really have lots more to do on that when I get a chance. My next project is to work on the advocacy page to showcase the club's participation in community events. There's so much we do and people should be able to find out more about our work. Also, if there's any features that people would like to see, I would again encourage folks to let me know. Some things might not be feasible, but if I can figure out how to do it, then I'll add it. I'll transfer some of that to our site as I learn.

Many people have come up to me and complimented the website. I just wanted to say thank you to all of those of you did. I hope to continue to make it better and better.

Many of the routes are now mapped on the bikely.com website. I'll have to finish up the rest next year, maybe while it is still freezing cold outside. If anyone wants to contribute, the best thing is

to send me a list of turns for a route so that I can enter them on the EBC account on bikely. That will keep them all in one place. Also, bikely.com is converting to bikeradar.com soon. When it does, I'll update the links on our website accordingly.

**New Routes?** Does anyone have any ideas for new routes for 2009? We need to shake things up to avoid boredom. What about a new century route? I was thinking there must be a way to get to Oakland City and back in around 100 miles. We could even consider starting a new century route from the Olmstead access road which would help put us further north.
