### **SPRING** Dave Ashworth


I know that there is a lot of talk concerning global warming, however, we in Southern Indiana must have missed out on this cycle. Here are my observations after not being able to ride the last of January and most of February. As a result of glaciations, the hills on the Elite ride along I64 are now much steeper than when I rode them last fall. Also, as a result of the retreat of the glacier, with the approach of spring, there has been continental rebound and now they are much higher. I made this observation as I rode last Saturday. I also noted that in the area near the turn south on the 35 mile route was basically Tundra, and I am not talking about the truck. The wind was blowing unobstructed off of the ice shield located to the North.

On a more serious note, along with spring riding we have pot holes as a result of the winter freeze/thaw cycle. If you are riding with a group, be sure to call out the hazard and point as a courtesy to those behind. Be careful since several of our regular roads have had considerable damage. I want to warn bike club members and others who use Old Henderson Road about a notorious speeder. I learned of him while having my car worked on recently. This is basically the information I have:

A young man named Jon Reis (don't hold me to the spelling) likes to race vehicles on Old Henderson Road. He goes 100 and even 120 miles per hour.

Others on the road are endangered. Reis passed a man on a motorcycle and threw up so much road matter that the rider almost ran off the road. The cyclist works at the shop where I had my car repaired.

Reis has wrecked many vehicles. Lately he mostly drives a new red Chevrolet pickup truck. His parents keep buying new vehicles, and he keeps wrecking them.

Such driving endangers those who travel Old Henderson Road, including bicyclists as well as people using motor vehicles. Reis himself lives on Old Henderson Road.

Most of this information is secondhand, but I think my sources are trustworthy. I don't know Reis, but he was in the repair shop when I overheard him boast of going 100 miles per hour and evading police.

Ann -- I want to thank you very much for passing this on. I ride a "tug-a-bug" with my 7 year old on that route occasionally in the summer. I will remember to be alert.


