Many of you reading this already know about the newly created, local Guitar Lab Cycling Team that was organized this year to support competitive cycling in our community. The Guitar Lab Cycling Team has long since been the dream of EBC member Mike Boren, and seeing it actually happening has been very rewarding. Thanks to all of you who have supported the team by sponsorship, purchasing team jerseys and kits, and encouraging us to pursue this dream.

Team Guitar Lab has had an exceptional first year. There have been several wins, three cyclists moved up in category, and we have had over thirty top twenty finishes! Team cyclists include Cameron Ashbrook, Mike Boren, Aaron Briner, Gregg Martin, Brian Trimborn and junior rider Tyler Hart. Hopefully, the 2011 team will be able to support more cyclists, increase our number of junior riders, and add women to the roster. We want to thank Ultimate Fit, Gilles Cycling & Fitness, and Evansville Living for sponsoring the team.

Our mission is to create an Evansville based, registered USA cycling team that can support, educate, and encourage the sport of cycling in junior, adult, and master racing categories. We encourage everyone interested in the sport to become a member of EBC, and this is one of the prerequisites for racing on the Guitar Lab Cycling Team.

As a registered USA cycling team, one of the responsibilities is to host an annual training event open to the public. This year, we are hosting a training ride to take place on Sunday, September 19th, 2010, at Burdette Park. This ride is a great way to get motivated for the Great Pumpkin Metric! The ride is a total of 45 miles and will begin with a no drop, flat 15 miles, perfect for families and beginners that will return to the start. Others can continue with the remaining 30 miles that will be sure to include some hills. The ride will have experienced riders leading the group and bringing up the rear. Additionally, a vehicle will be on-site should anyone need to be picked up or have a minor repair.

The ride starts at Burdette Park entrance. Look for our blue tent. Registration begins at 9:00 a.m. The ride starts at 10:00 a.m. Cost is \$5.00 for EBC members and \$10.00 for non-members. 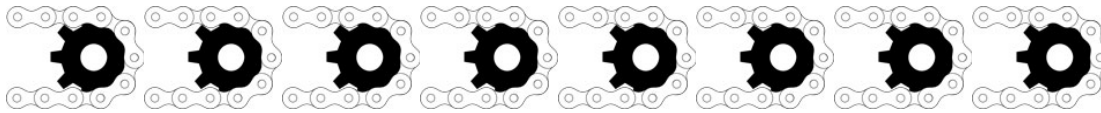
