Hello everyone,
The November meeting regarding the discussion of issues, provided the club with some recurrent themes that should provide the membership with some direction to go forward.

The following are what seemed to be the most consistent issues and concerns:

- Riders beginning before the designated starting time. There didn't seem to be as much concern about starting late; but starting early was objectionable to many.
- Rides continually get longer and longer—There was a time when the longest rides were 25 miles; even on week-ends. This practice assured that socializing could happen both before and after a ride because no-one would be too far out at the end.
- Club mileage? How vital is it? How far do we go with this? We continue to add miles to existing rides plus we add more rides per week. In 1999 there were a total of 180 club rides for the year, for July and August of this year EBC had on the schedule 109 rides with over 200 options available.
- The dwindling number of “hosted” rides—with some having rather serious mileage so that by the time some riders return other riders have already left!

- Advocacy continues to be a very important part of the club and we should continue to expand our focus. There was some concern that more members could be involved.

Think about it. The banquet is coming up and we are going to experience a venue that will be new to some and a return for others. The committee (Hope and Vicky) chose Kirby's for this year's festive occasion. Further information is found elsewhere in this issue. Remember, at the banquet we will also be electing officers for 2011.

All positions are up for re-election as per our by-laws. Openings for sure are secretary, membership, editor of the newsletter, and Touring. If you would be willing to serve, please contact one of the nominating committee members: Paul Jensen, Darlene Wefel, Hank Hudson, Jay Vercellotti or Rusty Yeager. The committee will announce those who have shown a desire or interest in one or any of the positions at the December meeting. However, the bylaws do open up nominations at the banquet for anyone who is a member and wishes to be considered for an office. Hope to see you at the December meeting as we will continue to discuss anything riding. And of course at the Annual Meeting (The banquet) on January 15 at Kirby's.

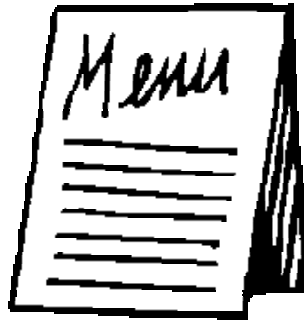

2010-11 HEATING ADVICE TO STAY SAFE AND SNUG AND SAVE MONEY

Winter cold can chill you, bill you—and even kill you if your heating system is unsafe.

Fuel to heat our homes can mean high bills. And heating increases the risks of fire, explosion and carbon monoxide poisoning.

But a heating system that works efficiently can mean more warmth, more safety—and more money left for other things.

The Evansville-Vanderburgh County Building Commission, Evansville Fire Department, Vanderburgh County township fire departments, American Red Cross, Vectren Corp. and your local heating and air conditioning contractors want to alert the citizens of Evansville and Southwestern Indiana to the dangers of carbon monoxide poisoning, fire and explosion from a malfunctioning furnace, a blocked flue or chimney, a broken gas line or inadequate air for combustion.

There could be hidden damage to your furnace, gas piping, flue or chimney. We are recommending that all citizens have their furnaces, space heaters, ranges, water heaters, gas lines, chimneys, flues and other heating equipment checked by a licensed heating contractor without further delay. (You should do this every year.) You will protect yourself and your family this winter and also **save on heating bills**.

Carbon monoxide replaces the oxygen in the air we breathe when fuel-burning equipment is operating and the vent or chimney is obstructed or there is not enough air to let the equipment burn fuel efficiently. Carbon monoxide is odorless, colorless and tasteless and catches its victims unaware, sometimes as they sleep. If you suspect a carbon monoxide problem, leave your home and call 911 or your local fire department.

Families in Evansville and across the country have been killed by carbon monoxide poisoning, and many others have become seriously ill. Symptoms may be similar to the flu, including headache, dizziness, nausea and shortness of breath. There may be fatigue and confusion. **That's if you're lucky: You may go to sleep and never wake up.**

Candle fires also have killed families. Be careful using candles during power outages and other times!

Help alert your family with carbon monoxide detectors and smoke detectors, available at all hardware stores, home centers and department stores. Regularly test detectors and change the batteries.

THEY CAN HELP

Evansville Urban Enterprise Association offers **free** carbon monoxide detectors and smoke detectors, while supplies last, to residents of the Enterprise Zone and the service areas outside the zone who have not received them in the past. Phone 426-2490.

Community Action Program of Evansville (CAPE) handles the Indiana Weatherization Assistance Program in Vanderburgh, Posey and Gibson counties. (Every county in Indiana has an agency for the weatherization program.) CAPE will repair or replace faulty heating equipment and make other energy-efficient improvements. CAPE also can help with heating bills. CAPE has income limits. Phone 425-4241.

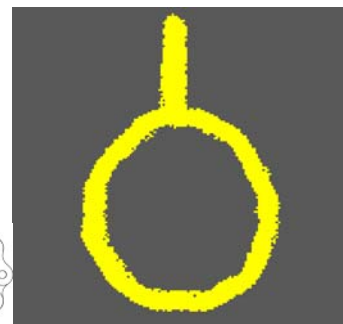
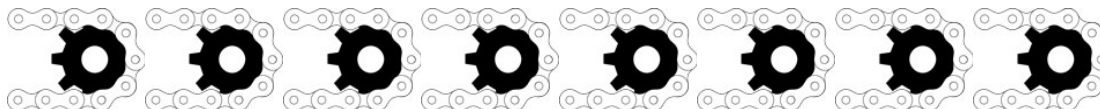
Memorial Community Development Corp. offers an emergency home repair program. A maximum grant of \$5,000 will cover repairs urgently needed to protect the occupants. The home must be occupied by the owner, and there are income limits. Phone 402-5530.

Also, **faith-based organizations, social agencies** and **township trustees** may be able to help make your heating system safer and help with heating bills.
