Advocate

Kudos to Sen. John Broden for pushing to protect Hoosier cyclists. State Senator John Broden of South Bend has introduced SB 0353 in the Indiana Senate. This bill has two components, the first of which is a three-foot passing law requested by Bicycle Indiana.

The second component is a mandatory helmet provision for minors under 18, which was requested by Indiana University Health. Bicycle Indiana recognizes that any language for mandatory helmet usage is a controversial subject with cyclists. We also recognize that most adult cyclists and their children wear helmets. This provision is not intended to create a hardship, and Indiana University Health is developing a program for free helmet distribution.
