May is National Bicycle Month while May 12-19 is National Bicycle Week. In the recent past Evansville has celebrated this week with two designated events: The "Ride of Silence" and the "Wurst Bike Ride". Both are being held this year and both are free!

The "Ride of Silence" is an event that is in its tenth year and has a three pronged purpose:

- To HONOR those who have been injured or killed by an automobile while riding
- To RAISE AWARENESS that cyclists are here
- To ask that we all SHARE THE ROAD

A recap of the 2011 event is as follows:

- ❖ 319 listed locations worldwide.
A record total!
- ❖ All 50 states + the District of Columbia
- ❖ 24 countries
- ❖ All 7 continents

In 2011, forty riders and ten supporters showed up to honor and show respect to this event and its messages. It is a small sacrifice to show support. The Evansville ride is just a bit over eight miles, is flat and will be escorted by at least two of Evansville's finest.

It begins and ends at the Evansville State Hospital and takes about an hour. On Wednesday, May 16th we will meet at 6:00 p.m. at the softball/baseball park and after some introductory remarks, begin the ride. The parking lot is located just a bit inside the entrance on Lincoln Ave. The ride travels through downtown, past the New Ford Center and weaves back to the hospital. There is no charge for this event.

The second event is the "Wurst Ride" which is not the way it sounds. This is a free bike ride along with free food and drink. If memory serves me right this is the fifth annual and is being billed as the wurst ever. The date is May 19th with an official start time of 9:30 a.m. The location remains the same with the start and end at Burdette Park near the BMX park. Last year drew 143 riders and

welcomes all categories and levels of cyclists.

After the Wurst ride on the West side, many of us will be heading straight North to volunteer at the second Marrs school bike rodeo. If you would like to help the school is located on highway 62 about mid-way between Evansville and Mt. Vernon on the left. Last year over 125 children went through the rodeo, played games, ate, drank and generally had a great time.

RIDE OF SILENCE Remembering Joyce Titzer

As Paul Jensen had mentioned, The Ride of Silence is coming. As his e-mail states: *"The ride will be exactly the same as the past two years. We again have the full support of the Evansville Police Department with at least two officers accompanying the riders. Last year we had 42 riders and would like to see that double."*

With this issue I would like us all to take a moment to dedicate this ride to Joyce Titzer, who was tragically killed while riding her bike on an Evansville Bicycle Club Outing in 1990. For those of you who may not know, our dear departed EBCer Tony Titzer, was married to Joyce. Tony, a few years later, had married Jane Buchta.



The date was October 21, 1990. A number of us had departed Highland School that Saturday morning for an overnight bicycle camp out up to Patoka Lake. Our gear was sagged so all we had to worry about was our bodies and our bikes. We had a great time, or so we thought. Less than a mile from the finish late that Sunday afternoon, Joyce, Tony and Dickie Lindenschmidt were ahead of us. Al Lewis,

Keith Weyer and Gene Brouillard had already finished and didn't know what happened until we rode up later and told them. A 16-year-old driver lost control driving north on a rain slick Darmstadt Road, crossed the centerline and struck all three of them. I was in the next group which happened upon the accident as they were strapping Tony into the ambulance.

Joyce had already been transported from the site. Dickie was in shock sitting there as paramedics attended to his wounds. Joyce died later that evening. Tony suffered a broken hip, arm and multiple contusions. Dickie suffered several broken ribs, a collapsed lung and a broken clavicle.

Thanks to Janet Robertson for the photo of Joyce, which she took that Saturday night in Patoka, and for jogging my memory of when it happened. Let's all remember Joyce on the ride as well as my grandson Sam Bellett who is on the mend, recovering from his injuries last Summer.

The Hills of Tennessee

On the weekend of March 30, 31 and April 1st, Kathy and I traveled to Gatlinburg to meet up with her family from Danville, Indiana and from Rock Hill, South Carolina. Kathy allowed me to take my bike (what a wife!) and I was able to get in a ride with the local bike club, the Foothill Striders.

It was their Saturday morning club ride and they were riding the route of what will be the 2012 Tour De Blount. It takes place in beautiful Blount County, Tennessee.

They offer rides of 29, 41, 62 (Metric Century) and 70. Since the 70 miler is called the "Wall" route, I opted for the 62 miler. I am not crazy about hills and I figured anything called The "Wall"

might not be to my liking. The circuit starts and ends in Maryville, Tennessee not too far from Gatlinburg. I started the ride with 3 of their members and finished with one of them and I had a great time.

I was concerned that 62 miles in that area might be all hills, but it really wasn't.

Lots of rollers, and 4-5 major climbs, but it IS in the Smoky Mountains after all. On Sunday I rode up to Newfound Gap, which is 13 miles of steady 5 to 5 1/2 % climb. Now THAT is a mountain.

But for anyone who is in the Gatlinburg area on May 12th of this year and wants a somewhat challenging, but scenic ride I would recommend the Tour De Blount.

Course: This road, criterium racecourse is a fast, .7-mile loop around the lake in historic Garvin Park. The wide-open course features several turns that are ideal for racing and spectating. Course is closed to traffic. Start and finish is west of the park fountain.

There will be food vendors along with sponsor and business vendor tents on-site. A kid's bike rodeo will be held in conjunction with the Evansville Bicycle Club.
