June did bust out all over! So many events went on in June that it kept members of the Evansville Bicycle Club busier than usual. The return of bicycle racing to the city, new and traditional volunteer efforts plus a couple of new ride routes kept the club hopping.

On the 2nd in the Blue Grass wildlife area four routes ranging from 7.9-9.7 miles were dedicated thanks to the Warrick County Commissioners and the efforts of Bike enthusiast Greg Meyer, an EBC member. About 20 EBC members were in attendance and rode at least one of the four routes. The next day found EBC volunteers assisting Boy Scout ---- with his Eagle Scout project on Bicycle Safety by staging a bicycle rodeo where over 60 bikers participated.

On Saturday the 9th bicycle racing returned to Evansville staged by the Guitar lab with 190 professional cyclists showing up at Garvin Park with EBC staging a skills course rodeo and many bike riders from EBC participating as competitors. On Saturday the 23rd a new city event "Streets Alive" closed Fulton Avenue for over a mile with dancing, walking and cycling events taking place up and down the street. One of the most popular booths was the EBC booth

where Bill Voegel's bicycle smoothie blender concocted over 40 batches of various flavored drinks to satisfy the thirst of hundreds of visitors. A bicycle rodeo was also mapped out which included both the safety street course and skills course challenge.

Finally on the 27th and 28th EBC volunteers for the 6th year pumped air into 100 bikes and fitted seats to the winners of a program sponsored by the Evansville Parks Department, Evansville Vanderburgh School Corporation, IVY Tech, Gerling Law and the Evansville Bicycle Club for children from seven EVSC grade and middle schools. The winners were evaluated on attendance, good attitude and good behavior.

As of this writing it appears that a new transportation bill will go into effect and it is not positive for those utilizing alternate forms of transportation (bikes and walking). According to reports from cycling organizations the funds for supporting Safe Routes to Schools (biking and walking) has been eliminated and local funding supporting walking/cycling initiatives have been cut by 60 to 70%. Consequently more creative means will have to evolve to keep some of the current programs running and proposed projects on time.

The month of July also looks chock full of biking opportunities so take advantage.

You might want to start off with the 4th of July ride hosted by Jane Buchta and Darlene Wefel. The ride begins at 9:00 am at the Newburgh Dam overlook. See the calendar for further details. I hope to see you there.
