e finally get a break!!! The month of August has proven to be much more conducive for cycling than either June or July, so enjoy. This month has also provided much information to those of us interested in cycling the following will provide you with a quick summary of some of these stories.

Kicking off with the new Federal legislation involving the Transportation bill that was mentioned in last month's column which could adversely cut funding for biking projects by up to 30% and then giving the power to the states to decide whether to fund the money for recreational projects (biking & walking projects) or other types of highway projects. Governor Mitch Daniels of Indiana signed on to continue funding projects that involve biking. This will continue projects such as the walking/bike trail from Sunset Park in Evansville to both the LST and Angel Mounds. Yahoo! And thank you Governor Daniels!

Early in the Spring I remember seeing a where a cyclist was intentionally side-swiped by an auto and because the cyclist had a camera attached to the front of his bike resulted in the camera picking up the license plate and consequently ending in an arrest by the authorities.

I thought that was something to be investigated. Then come to read that many cyclists, especially in the West, attach cameras to their helmets initially to record their rides, but as an added benefit to record confrontations with cars. The article went on to say that these cameras are available for as little as \$130.00. Sounds like something some of us might want to look into.

A solution that might help when it comes to the American attitude toward those of us who cycle on public roads. An interview with a European cyclist riding in the states revealed that in Europe Driver Education students are taught and reminded constantly in their classes that cyclists are to be respected and given the right of way in all instances. Something we might want to try here. It certainly would not hurt to try!

My personal opinion on Lance Armstrong and his being "stripped of his seven Tour de France victories" by the United States Anti-Doping Association (USADA). The original purpose of this association is the testing of American Olympic hopefuls and is now seemingly making a power play making a reputation trying to take over many other sports. Armstrong has been defending himself for the past seven years since his last Tour victory plus the seven years before that by being tested over 500 times sometimes being awakened in the middle of the night during competitions to be tested. In almost all "random" testing he somehow was the person randomly picked—out of 190 or so riders. How long would any of us last being hounded most every day with those accusations. Armstrong brought millions of Americans into the cycling world who previously had no interest in "The Tour" let alone professional cycling. Again, if you never failed a drug test and was never proven positive what more is there to say? It appears that the only way the USADA can get "proof" is by strong arming and threatening other riders with sanctions unless they "fess up" leads me to have very little respect for the work of the USADA.
