Next year in the biking world will bring about some changes. Indications are that Evansville is beginning to turn the page on attitudinal changes and practices toward alternative means of transportation (in our case biking).

The widening of Oak Hill Road from Pigeon Creek to Lynch Road which will include bike lanes. The Civil Engineering senior class from the University of Evansville chose as its project to map a route from Sunset Park to Angel Mounds. In conjunction with this plan is to extend a riding/walking path from the levee to the LST.

The Evansville Area Trails Coalition is searching for a full time Executive Director to begin work on developing new trails and bike routes in and around the city.

A serious move toward making Evansville a Bicycle Friendly City as recognized by the League of American Bicyclists.

And finally changes in the way Evansville citizens will be able to shop for bicycles, accessories and service/repair locally.

Now as I understand it:

Gilles Cycling (Dan's Comp)

Long time retailer Gilles Cycle and Fitness (70 years and three generations) has been acquired by Dan's Comp of Mt. Vernon (which will also remain in Mt. Vernon) will retain the Gilles name but will be offering only bicycles and bicycle related products and service.

Ultimate Fit who shares floor space with Gilles will be offering its current inventory of running shoes and clothing but will add fitness equipment to its inventory.

Breck's Bicycle Shop Eric Muffet reports that they are continuing with their current offerings of Cannondale and Specialized Road bikes. And if you go to the Festival of Lights at Garvin Park, the display of the cyclist is now sponsored by Breck's.

Top Spot Outdoors & Bicycles will continue to offer road bike Fuji and have added AeroCat to its inventory.

Bike Doctor is the exclusive dealer for Giant road bicycles as well as clothing and service

Scheller's Fitness and Cycling

The new bike store in town Scheller's has been a successful bicycle oriented business expanding to five shops (two in Louisville, two in Lexington and one in Clarksville, IN).

As of this writing the location is undetermined, but Manager Kyle Rickenbaugh is hoping to open "before Christmas". It is a homecoming of sorts for owners Greg, Tim and Marty Scheller as they are Evansville natives, attending Memorial High School and the University of Evansville. I can't remember this many bike shops in Evansville. This will give all EBC members quite a variety of choices when it comes to the purchase of bicycles as well as service and repair. Another sign that Evansville is becoming a bicycle friendly community.

UNSCRIPTED: FIG NEWTONS FUEL GREAT PUMPKIN BICYCLE TOUR

If you have a friend who is fit and fabulous enough to qualify for the next Boston Marathon, you might not want her selecting which route you're going to ride in the Great Pumpkin Metric. I speak from experience.

The Great Pumpkin Metric is an annual bicycle tour of Southwestern Indiana sponsored by the Evansville Bicycle Club. Riders have their choice of a 100K, 50K or 25K route. I should have known Michelle would pick the 100K route. That's how she rolls.

The program literature described her chosen route as follows: "The 100K route is challenging. Riders will have some steep climbs and rolling hills, along with some nice flat areas."

Maybe it's just me, but I think it goes without saying that 62 miles is a challenging bike ride. And I consider Nurrenbern Hill just past the Burdette Park entrance to be more of a small mountain than a "steep climb." Clearly, the pumpkin planners are masters of understatement.

But, they provided rescue wagons along the route and a spaghetti bar at the end; I had nothing to lose but my dignity and my ability to walk. And so I set out on the 100K route with Michelle and her marathon friends on a crisp Sunday morning in late September.

Any doubts I had about the event in general and route in particular vanished when I arrived at the first rest stop. They had everything a hungry woman could want

including, but not limited to, peanut butter sandwiches, fruit, candy and my personal favorite, Fig Newtons.

There would be three more such stops along the route. However, before I could get to any of them, I had one notable gauntlet to pass — Nurrenbern Hill. This hill may not seem to be a big deal to the motorized traveler. But it's a whole different ballgame when your body is the motor.

Even Phil, a marathon riding wonder like Michelle, agreed with my assessment.

"This hill's kind of tough," he said as he passed me going up it. Clearly Phil is a master of understatement, too.

By my estimation, I had just enough energy for breathing and pedaling, and nothing more — such as responding to Phil or even blinking.

Another bounty of Fig Newtons rewarded me at the top of the hill, along with a group of fellow Nurrenbern Hill survivors.

Somewhere around mile 40, I gave up my dream of keeping up with Michelle and Phil. I'd been pushing myself to go faster than I wanted and, in doing so, I'd taken the fun out of a recreational bike ride. From that point on, the route became slower but more fun. I passed mile after mile of rolling cornfields, punctuated by the occasional church spire and one final rest stop featuring live music and an inviting park bench.

With the possible exception of Fig Newton consumption, I didn't break any records that day. But I did experience a few
