# PAUL JENSEN THE PRESIDENT'S CORN

o the dreaded month of Febru-ucky is about to end. My personal "worst" month that is COLD, Windy, and always seemingly darkis about to expire. I am also glad it is the shortest. Winter sports are in the middle of their seasons and most of the athletes can't see the light at the end of the tunnel when playoffs and championships will begin. The regularity of seeing cyclists is extremely rare save for those truly dedicated. But March will intermittently show signs of change for the better. Daylight hours are longer, daylight savings time changes our perspective as darkness comes an hour later, temperatures rise and we look at our bicycles differently. March will have at least two or three days that will meet our personal criteria for riding and we will get out, pump up the tires, grease the gears and get in at least a 17 or 23. What a wonderful feeling!!

But many of the preparations for a great year of local cycling have been going on over the winter months and much of it begins in February. Meetings are being held preparing for the second "Streets Alive" to be held on Fulton Avenue where the EBC bicycle powered smoothie machine was introduced and was an instant hit. The "new and improved" model should be ready by the May 19th event. Plans for the second River City Bicycle Classicrace at Garvin Park on June 8th have been ongoing with EBC heading up the Kids races and kids events. EBC is preparing to host the Ride of Silence for the fourth year which will be held on Wednesday, May 15. Being an active member of the Evansville Area Trails Coalition, EBC is in strong support of proposed trail which will start at the top of the levee on Waterworks Road and end at Angel Mounds. The senior Civil Engineering class from the University of Evansvillechose as their senior project to design and plan a workable trail. The class proposed three different routes with the one chosen to be developed with specific details.

The proposed trail will be eight feet wide and be of a rock surface. Initially the surface will not be overly conducive to road bikes, but in time will become finer as used. Much of the trail will depend on volunteers picking a portion of the trail to develop and maintain. Sounds like a great project for a club like EBC! Five years ago when the project was first

proposed the cost was predicted at \$18,000,000. The seven mile trail with bells and whistles should top out at \$1,000,000. If all goes as planned we could by riding on it by the end of 2014. Quite a bit different the 40 years to complete the trail could be up and Quite a savings.

Darlene Wefel will be representing EBC, Southern Indiana and the state of Indiana at the National Bicycle Summit to be held next week in Washington, D.C. We are anxious to hear what she has to report. Our own Bicycle Indiana summit will be held March 14-16 with most of the type of input and information that EBC members might be interested in will be held on Saturday.

Maybe we could get a carload to travel up EARLY Saturday morning (it begins @ 8:00 a.m. eastern time) to gather information and put in our two cents worth. Go to the Bicycle Indiana website for further information. http://www.bicycleindiana.org/ and click on summit. That's it for this month!

I hope to see you at least once when that special day of criteria comes about for our initial 17 or 23 miler.
