

# PAUL JENSEN THE PRESIDENT'S CORNER

When the clock struck summer the weather gods were listening. The weather folks say it is not as hot as last year, but that's because it was in the three digits no just 90's. This past month of nice spring weather triggered quite a few riders to get out and do their thing.

The River City Bicycle Classic turned out to be a weather and people friendly success. EBC was in charge of the kids' races and putting on a kid's rodeo. We also passed out bicycle safety information and encouraged people to join EBC. Members Gary Gardner and Bob Fodstad, as race marshals, had an unwanted cyclist riding the wrong way on the course in their domain and just barely averted a head on disaster. The gentleman appeared to have been imbibing a bit too much of the grape.

EBC was instrumental in assisting in the 8th annual bike giveaway sponsored by the EVSC, Parks and Recreation and Ivy Tech. These bikes went to children participating in the summer enrichment program between the ages of six and fourteen. Out of the 800 children participating, 125 bikes were awarded. To be eligible win a bike the child had to demonstrate good behavior, good attendance, and a good attitude throughout the program. The first role played by EBC was to promote safety by showing a video on safety and rules of the road followed by a short lecture along with practicing turns and stop signals. Secondly we made sure all bikes were in top notch condition when the winners were announced. This included pumping up 200+ tires and making adjustments to brakes and gears plus wheel alignment. EBC volunteers also adjusted seat posts to fit the child to their bikes. Finally EBC set up a skills course for the winners to get out and ride their bikes right then and there. The smiles on the kids' faces as they were announced were priceless! There are pictures of the event elsewhere in this newsletter.

It makes me tired just writing about this one. On June 15/16 three EBC riders participated in the 24 hour race in Middleville, Michigan. In the 50-54 Rusty Yeager finished 8<sup>th</sup> with a total of 362.4 mile with David Kuykendall at 22<sup>nd</sup>with 302.4 miles ridden. Archie Carter raced in the 60-64 year age group and finished 13<sup>th</sup> traveling 339.1 miles. Congratulations to each and a reminder that your mental examination is scheduled for next week.

Coming up and again in need of volunteers will be the week long "I Can Ride" program (July 15-19) sponsored by the Easter Seals Rehabilitation Center. This program will include approximately 30 children with mild physical and mental disabilities to learn how to ride a two wheeled bicycle in five days. Volunteering for this program is a bit different in that you volunteer your service for the same time of day (1½ hours per day for the week. So if you can fit this into your schedule please do by calling Patty Balbach at 812-479-1411. EBC will again gladly donate two scholarships plus one adaptive bicycle to the program.

July will also see many of our kind travel to Terre Haute to attempt the 162 mile journey to Richmond, IN. Have a great ride and good luck. The date July 13.

The middle and end of next month will also see some of our Senior riders heading to Cleveland, Ohio to participate in the National Senior Games. I know of two who will be competing so Good Luck to Bill Voegel and Steve Gerbig.

I hope to see you on the road---or at a volunteer effort!!!

She was young when the tornado came through here and did so much damage. It made her especially sad to know of the children who died in the storms.
