THE PRESIDENT'S CORNER



So what is about five (5) weeks away? The **32nd annual GREAT PUMPKIN METRIC (GPM) road tour** of course. This is the club's main source of income to assist in funding bicycle related issues the club deems worthy. Much help is needed to pull this off successfully and that means YOU!

The main reason for my becoming a member in 1999 was due to my first experience as a GPM entrant. Riding independently, I was riding about 20 miles per day three to four times per week and thought this might be a good experience. I sent in an entry and thought riding the 50k was something that was within my reach.....so I went for it. The bike I rode was a 1995 a pale bluish-green (the only color made) Bianchi Boardwalk-a hybrid with 18 gears. I was pretty nervous having never been a part of such a large group of riders. Having no idea of the protocol of cycling (Dan Henry's, "on your left", signaling at turns) I read my instructional materials and left on my own. The first big challenge was **THE HILL** at about the nine or ten mile mark. This hill made many of the cyclists temporary pedestrians as they walked their bikes up the hill. After **barely conquering THE HILL** it was imperative that the promised rest stop appear soon....and there it was- Yeley's rest stop. Water, Gatorade, trail mix, porta potti, what more could you want. The rest of the ride was absolutely Euphoric which included the wind aided

last 8 or 9 miles after the St. Wendel rest stop.

At the end of the ride joining the EBC was a no brainer. Riding the scheduled weekly rides was not a priority; paying the \$12.00 to reassure that the **GREAT PUMPKIN METRIC** would be held the next year was the most important reason for joining. It worked! The tradition still is being carried on as my \$12.00 is still helping put together the 2013 **GPM**.

Two events that have become quite regular in the schedules of EBC volunteers are the Boonville Wal-Mart Rodeo and the Evansville Otters helmet fitting in partnership with St. Mary's-Kohl's Safe Kids program. EBC members partnered with the Boonville Bicycle Club by Brad Scales on the third venture on Sat. the 10th. Four bicycles were presented at the end to lucky rodeo participants. Fifteen EBC bike helmet fitters showed up on the 23rd to fit 300+ helmets to various sized heads and after running out of helmets found seats in the bleachers and cheered on the home team.

From The League of American Bicyclists: The Bicycle Friendly State program is designed to establish best practices — we know every state has great riding opportunities, dedicated state-agency staff, determined advocates and cyclists of all stripes working to make a state great for cycling. The League annually ranks all 50 states on how bikeable they are. We do this based on a multi-faceted Bicycle Friendly State(BFS) questionnaire that is answered by each state's Bicycle Coordinator. Because of an overlap in data collected for the League's Bicycle Friendly States program and the Alliance for Biking and Walking's Benchmarking Report, the League and Alliance partnered in 2012 and merged the two state surveys to eliminate redundancy and simplify the process for respondents. The data collected is verified by League staff in concert with advocates in each state. States that continue to promote bicycling and improve conditions can expect to improve their scores. The BFS annual ranking measures the states bikeability but does not include everything states can and should do for bicycling. The BFS ranking process illustrates general performance needs. Traditionally, the BFS rankings show that there are fantastic efforts to emulate and there is still a lot of work to be done to increase bikeability in states from the bottom to the top of the BFS ranked list.
