## Cycling in The Florida Keys

It's with a little trepidation that I write about this, especially since Evansville is in a current deep freeze during the first part of the new year. But I must say that after visiting and riding in the Keys, it is quite the place to ride.

What got me started and convinced me to take the bike on a recent vacation trip was research and reading about the Florida Keys Overseas Heritage Trail (FKOHT). Although not quite yet finished, it is well worth the trip and the ride. When complete, you will be able to ride 107 miles from Key Largo to Key West across 37 bridges, many off-limits to cars, and

where headwinds are the norm. But warm weather abounds.

The route--while still under construction--varies in length for each completed section. For instance, Key Largo, through slamorada and into Marathon (where I was staying) are 47 miles before you reach the famous "Seven-Mile Bridge" made historical by Henry Flagler the railroad tycoon and a Labor Day hurricane in 1935 obliterated parts of the bridge and railways gave way to autos. I was amazed at the number of cyclists I saw and one could get the idea that, once the trail is finished, an even larger resurgence of two-wheels will

emerge. Unfortunately, I was only able to ride two of the seven miles. Again, thanks to the hurricane. Luckily, the new Seven Mile Bridge has shoulders wide enough for riders.

I didn't venture out onto the new bridge to ride from Marathon down to Bahia Honda and back as it was getting dark; I didn't bring lights and supper was waiting back at the rental. Hopefully that would come another day.

Talk about that wind? Riding South, I was averaging about 13. On the way back North--with a tailwind--my pace increased to almost 20.

Of the FKOHT, currently 70 miles are specifically paved right-of-way for cyclists, runners, etc. the remainder is shared with traffic until engineering plans are completed, funds allocated and construction can begin based on the overall master plan.

Interestingly, despite the number of cyclists I saw during the week between Islamorada and Key West, I did not see any typical bike shops. There were, of course, bike rental stores in

abundance in Key West, but then again, that's the only easy way for locals and tourists to get around other than on foot. Pedicabs were in abundance, too.

Should any EBC'ers want to consider taking their bikes on a trip to The Keys, I would heartily recommend it.
