On Friday November 27 we will also have our annual Day after Thanksgiving Day ride. It is held at Dogtown Boat

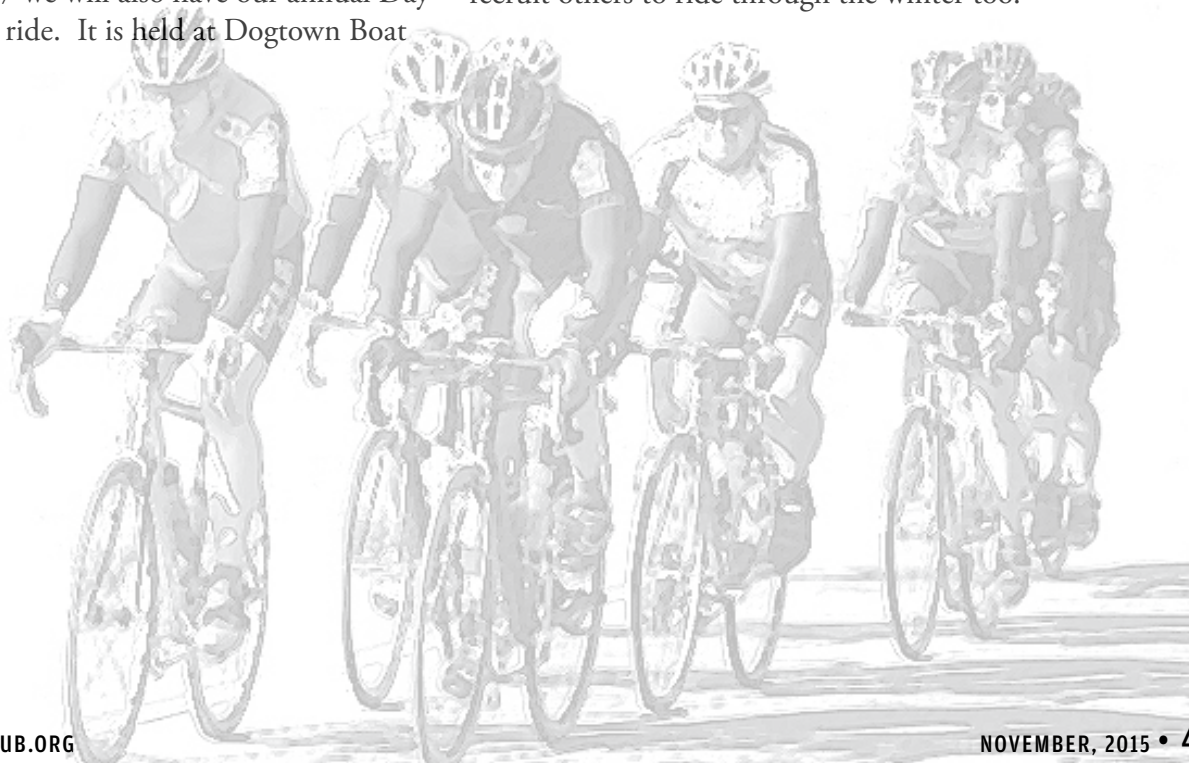
Ramp on Old Henderson Rd. What a great way to get out and work off that feast you over ate on Thanksgiving Day!

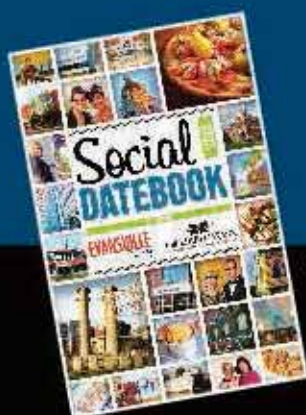
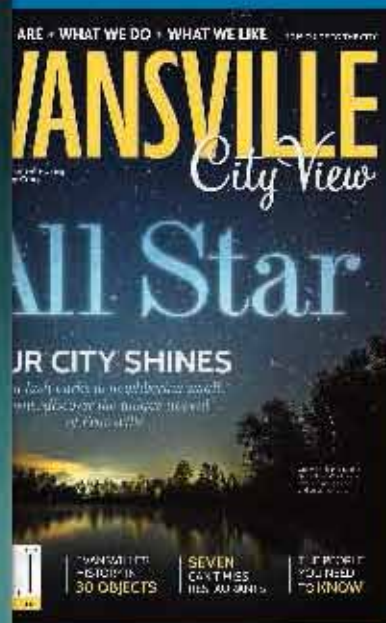
