May is National Bicycle Month

May 16 through May 20 is Bike to Work Week with a special focus on Friday May 20 as Bike to Work Day.

So much to do this month!! Please look at the calendar in detail. There are a lot of changes to the schedule start times and the ride locations have moved some as well. Notably the Saturday ride is now at Dogtown for the summer, the Wednesday night rides are starting at the Shirley James Gateway Plaza which is the parking lot alongside the Lloyd Expressway just west of Fulton Avenue. All evening rides start at 6:00 pm. Sunday afternoons now start at 3:30 pm. Thursday night rides are at Mesker Park this month.

Our annual RIDE OF SILENCE is to be held on Wednesday May 18 at the State Hospital Grounds off of Lincoln Avenue. This ride starts at 6:00. Please arrive early to line up and hear announcements before leaving with our police escort. Bring all your friends with bicycles. This is a very slow, quiet ride. 2016 Indiana State Senior Games

The cycling events for the 2016 Indiana State Senior Games, which are qualifiers for the 2017 National Senior Games, will be Sunday, May 22, at the Physical Activities Center (PAC) at the University of Southern Indiana. Cyclists aged 50 years and older are welcome to participate.

The events will include one 5 km time trial, one 10 km time trial, and one 20 km road race. Both time trials will use the same loop course used in the past, which starts on Happe Road just south of the intersection with Cypress Dale Road. The road race will be on the demanding loop that starts on Broadway Avenue at the USI softball field parking lot.

Competitive groups will be divided by gender and by age in 5-year increments, starting at age 50. Age classification will be based on the rider's birthday age this calendar year.

Participants should register online at www.SWIRCA.org by May 6th. That is not a dropdead deadline. Just requested.

Check-in time will be at 8:00 a.m. at the PAC on May 22.

In addition to competitors, we need lots of volunteers to help with registration, timing/placing, and course marshaling/traffic control. Please contact Holly Schneider at SWIRCA (812-492-7440) or Steve Gerbig (812-598-1372) to volunteer.

Historically, we've had a wide range of participants in these races. We've had National Games medalists, including at least one gold medalist, along with Cat 1 and Cat 2 licensed racers. Yet we've also had riders who've never raced before.

If you've always wanted to try your hand at racing, the 2016 Indiana State Senior Games is the perfect opportunity to start. It's a very low pressure, low key and friendly event.
