The President's Letter

I just returned from another great adventure with the Fuller Center for Housing and some great EBC members. Bill Johnson, Mickey Flynn, and I went to Valley, Alabama for a week of rehabbing a home for a couple in need.

There were approximately 100 to 150 other workers who also helped on the house where we worked or worked on three new homes that were constructed. was the completion of the Kentucky Century Challenge by Charles Jones and I. Several others completed this last year and Charles did three of the designated four events. This year we did all four as required and earned our "free" jerseys. I also recommend this activity. You might as well start planning for next year.

More current events to look forward to include the Great Pumpkin Metric coming up this weekend! I am very excited to see how our rest stops carry out our theme of School Days. Please come and check it out for yourself. We have jerseys available for sale this year too.
