Our Saturday rides are all over the place this month. The normal ride time on Saturdays is still 9:00. However in November we are having more 10:00 Saturday rides due to various considerations.

Watch the calendar for location and times for the Saturday morning rides.

The afternoon rides still start consistently at 1:00 and are mostly at Elite Fitness off of Kansas and highway 57. We actually park on the access road off of Seib just north of Elite Fitness.

There is a CLUB MEETING THIS MONTH on Thursday, November 10 at the Roca Bar on S. Kentucky Ave. The food there is great. The meeting starts at 6:30 but you are encouraged to come around 6:00 for some dinner and social time. We also are planning to hold GPM meetings at 5:15 or 5:30 each month so we can get started planning early. Please come and share your input. We will also meet in December on the second Thursday, December 8.

As always in November we have the Pumpkin Pie ride coming up on Saturday November 19 at Mark and Debbie Oliver's home. This promises to be a fun and well attended ride. Mark your calendar now! Lots of fun and good food for all! Remember that even if the weather is bad, you should come for the social aspect of the after-ride party. This ride starts at 10:00 AM and the party usually starts around 11:30 I believe.

On Friday November 25 we will also have our annual Day after Thanksgiving Day ride. It is held at Dogtown Boat Ramp on Old Henderson Rd. What a great way to get out and work off that feast you over ate on Thanksgiving Day!

Come out to join us on Wednesday nights after work for circles in the park at 6:00 PM. We ride for an hour and or up to 20 miles. Overnight Accomodation Network for Cross-Country Cyclists.

It was about 7:30 pm, Thursday, October 20th, when my family and I stopped in at Mickey "D's" for a snack as we were traveling north for our annual Blue Ridge Weekend Trek. My eyes immediately affixed upon a Surly bike adorned with panniers, lights, and the usual ecoutrements of a self-contained cross-country cyclist leaning against the wall.

Sitting inside was Carry, a well-tanned Northeastern Senior, probably late '60s sitting at a table checking his phone. I struck up a conversation with him to find out he had started in upstate New York—traveled into Canada—and back out to New York and was on his way to Key West to "party a little." His wife had passed away while living in the UK, so he decided to move back to the US

and see the country by bike. I asked about his accommodations along the way and he responded that there's a national network of Home Hosts called "Warm Showers." It's website is www.warmshowers.org

And there's a cell phone app.

It's really neat. Carry was explaining that he was trying to contact his next "warm shower," and sofa/backyard to sleep in. His host was about 20 miles away, and he had 75 miles in for the day as he was trying to average 100 per day. Rather than explain it all here, do your own investigation and see what you think.
