EBC Meeting Minutes for October 13, 2016

Attendance:

Diane Bies, Bill Majors, Kevin Otolowski, Jim Niethammer, John Nelli, Dan Armstrong, Sherry Plouchard, Jay Vercelotti, Mark Oliver, Paul Jensen, Mike Spearin, Alicia Spearin, and Ken Herrmann.

Call to Order

The informal social and discussion of the past Great Pumpkin Metric (GPM) began at 6:00 at the Roca Bar and Diane Bies called the meeting to order at 6:30.

Minutes:

Minutes from the previous meeting were read and approved without amendments. (Moved, Majors; Second, Oliver)

Treasury:

The treasury report was circulated, discussed and accepted without amendments. (Moved, Oliver; second Nelli)

Webmaster Report:

In the past month there were 428 Facebook users and 1600 website visitors.

Old Business:

Century Rides – A New Harmony route is in development stages and the Mount Vernon route is complete and ready for scheduling. (Information only)

Tree Tunnel Ride – The new Tree Tunnel ride is under review due to concerns for safety in two locations. (Tabled for future discussion)

Boston Pizza Ride – A new ride from Boston Pizza at Epworth and the Lloyd Expressway awaits approval from the restaurant for use of their parking lot. (Tabled for future discussion)

GPM Jersey – Eighty of the 100 jerseys ordered for the GPM were sold this month at \$55 each. The remainder will be available for sale to EBC members at \$40 each. (Information only)

Annual Banquet – The annual banquet was held at Kirby's last year. This year the banquet will be held on a Saturday in mid- or late-January. Restaurant reservations have not been confirmed and suggestions for the location are under consideration; suggestions are welcome. Last year the cost for attending was: \$15/individual, \$30/couple, \$40/family. The cost for attending this year will increase: \$20/individual, \$40/couple, \$50/family. (Tabled for future discussion)

New Business:

GPM Sponsorship – The GPM has been sponsored by Dan's Comp located in Mount Vernon and Evansville.

During the GPM this year, an EBC member was overheard to say that Scheller's, a competing bike shop, does not contribute to GPM sponsorship. The remark was related to Kyle, manager of Scheller's in Evansville.

The remark was considered offensive because Dan's Comp was previously granted overall "TITLE" sponsorship of the ride. Scheller's has felt being a minor sponsor is not rewarding to them as Dan's name is on everything and the riders who came did not recognize Scheller's as being a

separate bike shop. However Scheller's continues to provide a SAG support driver and support vehicle each year. Both shops are considered to be important to support the local cycling community. EBC members were asked to refrain from making negative remarks about either bike shop in any context. You never know who might be hearing you and misunderstand what you are saying. (Information only)

EBC Meeting Sponsorship – Bike shops have hosted monthly EBC meetings in the past and provided cycling demonstrations and information. No sponsored meetings have been held recently or are currently scheduled. It was suggested that both local shops be offered the opportunity to host meetings in 2017. Two EBC members will approach the shops to explore their interest in hosting future meetings. (Tabled for future discussion)

Share-the-Road Signs – A member of the running community requested support for signs. The EBC has purchased 25 signs on 2 occasions and posted them in Vanderburgh and Warrick counties. Individuals have also purchased and posted signs. Future sign purchases might include the images of cars, runners and cyclists. The EBC might wish to add more community signs, but the locations for these signs were not discussed. There was no motion to purchase or post more signs. (Tabled for future discussion)

Thanks – The EBC received several thank you notes. The notes are available from Diane for members to read. (Information only)

Future GPM Organization – The GPM is a challenge to organize and administer. More EBC members are needed at the event for various support jobs. The GPM organizers have complex roles that have not been clearly defined. The lack of job descriptions was viewed as an organizational liability in the event that an organizer becomes unavailable due to illness, injury or other reasons. More advanced planning was suggested. It was proposed that these issues be handled in a monthly GPM committee meeting to be held immediately prior to the social portion of the monthly EBC meetings. (Tabled for future discussion)

Dan Henry Markings – The "Dan Henry" marks on the roads require periodic revision. They will be refreshed this fall. The cost of paint is provided by the EBC, including paint needed for "hosted" club rides. (Information only)

Future Rides – The Pumpkin Pie Ride (15/27/33) will be held at 1000 on November 19, the Saturday before Thanksgiving at 7508 Ridgeway Drive. TDE rides will continue to be added to the EBC ride schedule. (Information only)

EBC Meeting Minutes – It was suggested that the members in attendance at the meetings be emailed a copy of the minutes of the meeting whether they attend the next meeting or not. The meeting minutes have never been part of the monthly newsletter in the past. Diane said she would like to discuss the possibility of posting them there. The reality is that the minutes are often not typed up much before the meeting/ (Tabled for future discussion)
