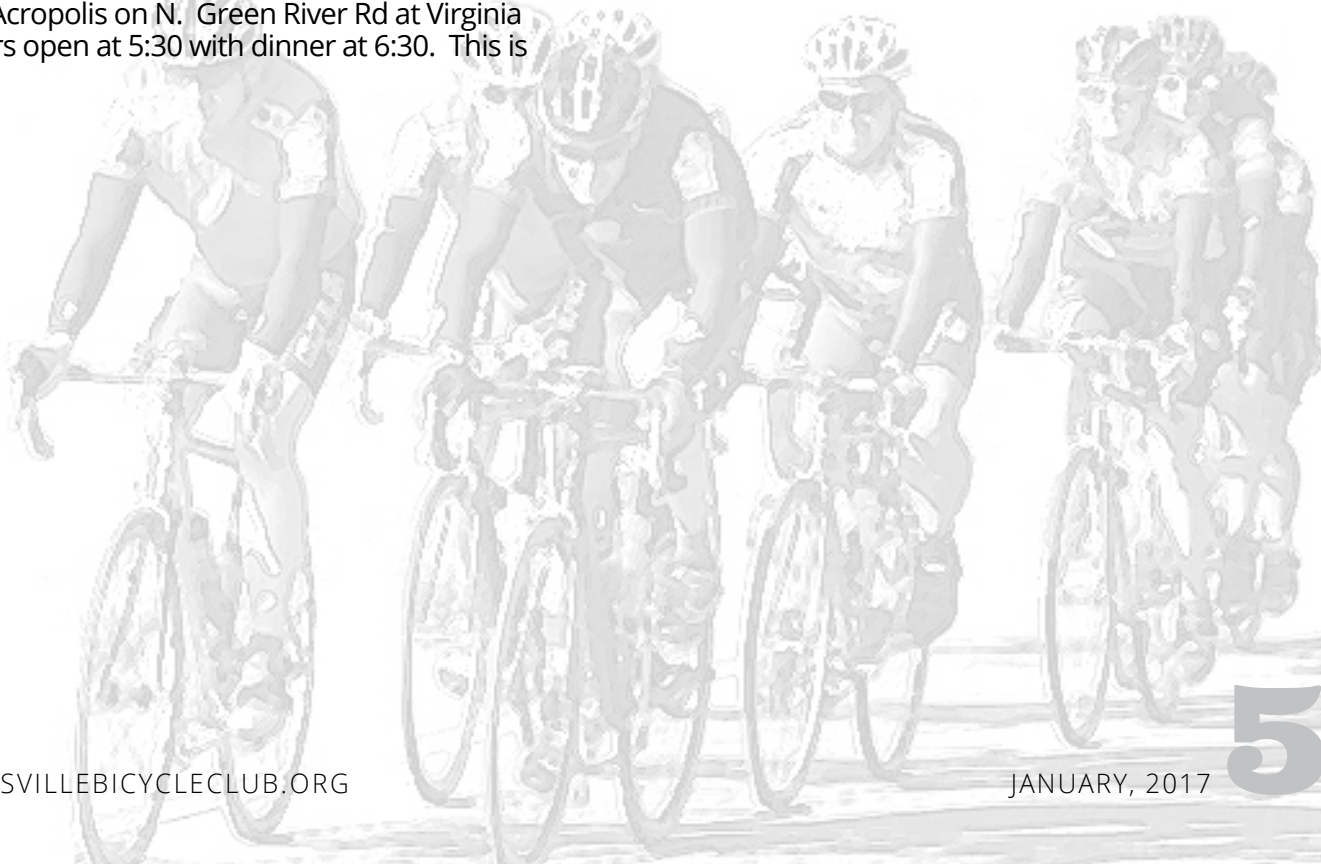
Ride hosts
