In consideration of my or my child s participation in this event, I/We the undersigned on behalf of myself, my child, my/my child sheirs, representatives, executors and assigns Do Hereby Release the EBC Inc., its officers, directors, volunteers, agents and sponsors from any cause of action, claim or demands of any nature whatsoever, including a claim of negligence by the EBC Inc., its officers, directors, employees, volunteers, agents and sponsors arising from or related to my/my child participation this ride.
