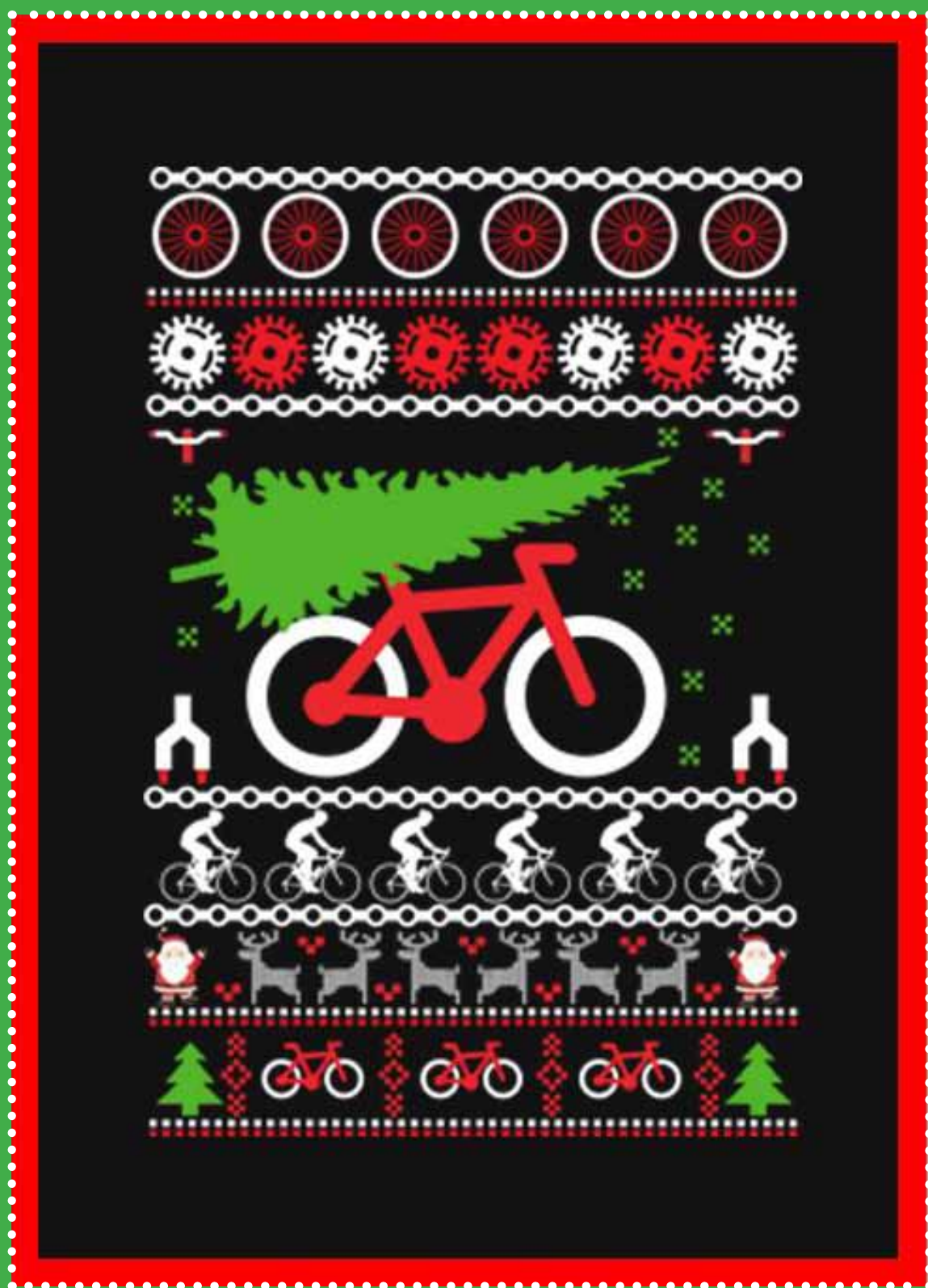

The President's Letter

As November comes to a close, I reflect on another wonderful month. I have so much to be thankful for, but the friends I have gained and experiences I've had through EBC are at the top of my Thanksgiving list.

I had the pleasure of riding on a recent Tuesday morning ride before the scheduled Thursday club century. Knowing I might be able to recruit someone, I threw out the idea of doing the century.

To my delight both John Bosko and Jim Niethammer expressed interest. Tight on daylight hours, we started out at 8 AM (34 degrees, grey and damp, heading north into a very chilly headwind) looking forward to the sun coming out around 10 AM. The sun never came out, the roads never really dried, and the temperature topped out at 37.

But my heart was warm with good friends and mostly my body was never too cold. John said he was pleasantly surprised because his previous low riding temp was 44, 10 degrees warmer than our morning start temp. Jim led us on a very enjoyable route to New Harmony where we all enjoyed a coffee at Black Forest Coffee Brewery.

Shortly after heading back towards Evansville, I looked over my right shoulder at the right time to see a lighter spot in the clouds. It was our only sighting of the sun that day. We made it in before sunset with no real traffic issues and not too cold at all.

That outing was followed by Mark and Debbie Oliver's wonderful annual Pumpkin Pie Ride. Although the route was well planned and marked, the weather kept everyone off their bikes. It was warm but VERY

windy and raining. A nice crowd came to help eat the wonderful food the Olivers had prepared. We were treated to pumpkin pie of course along with lots of other delicious food. It is so great to have opportunities to come together with

other bikers, not on our bicycles. We can actually visit with fellow club members with no concerns of traffic, pot holes, turns, or hills. Thanks you so much Mark and Debbie.

Today was another example of feeling

the extreme love in this club. We started the Sunday afternoon ride with 9 riders. Two were only going 24 miles while the rest of us were doing 33. At one point I dropped off the faster pack of riders doing the longer route. Two others backed off and waited for me. Just down the road we found the rest of the group had pulled off to wait for the three of us. So we proceeded to ride the rest of the route as a group in spite of the differences in usual riding speeds. (Of course I was the weakest link, but they were all so kind!)

Lastly I must say how great it is to have other cyclists show up for rides after the riding season has ended for so many. It's nice to know there are others riding in the dark parks on Wednesday evenings, even if I am doing circles alone at my own pace. Sunday afternoons when we all ride together are so awesome. Any ride, any time, anybody...riding is just much more fun with other people and I am so grateful for all the people in EBC!

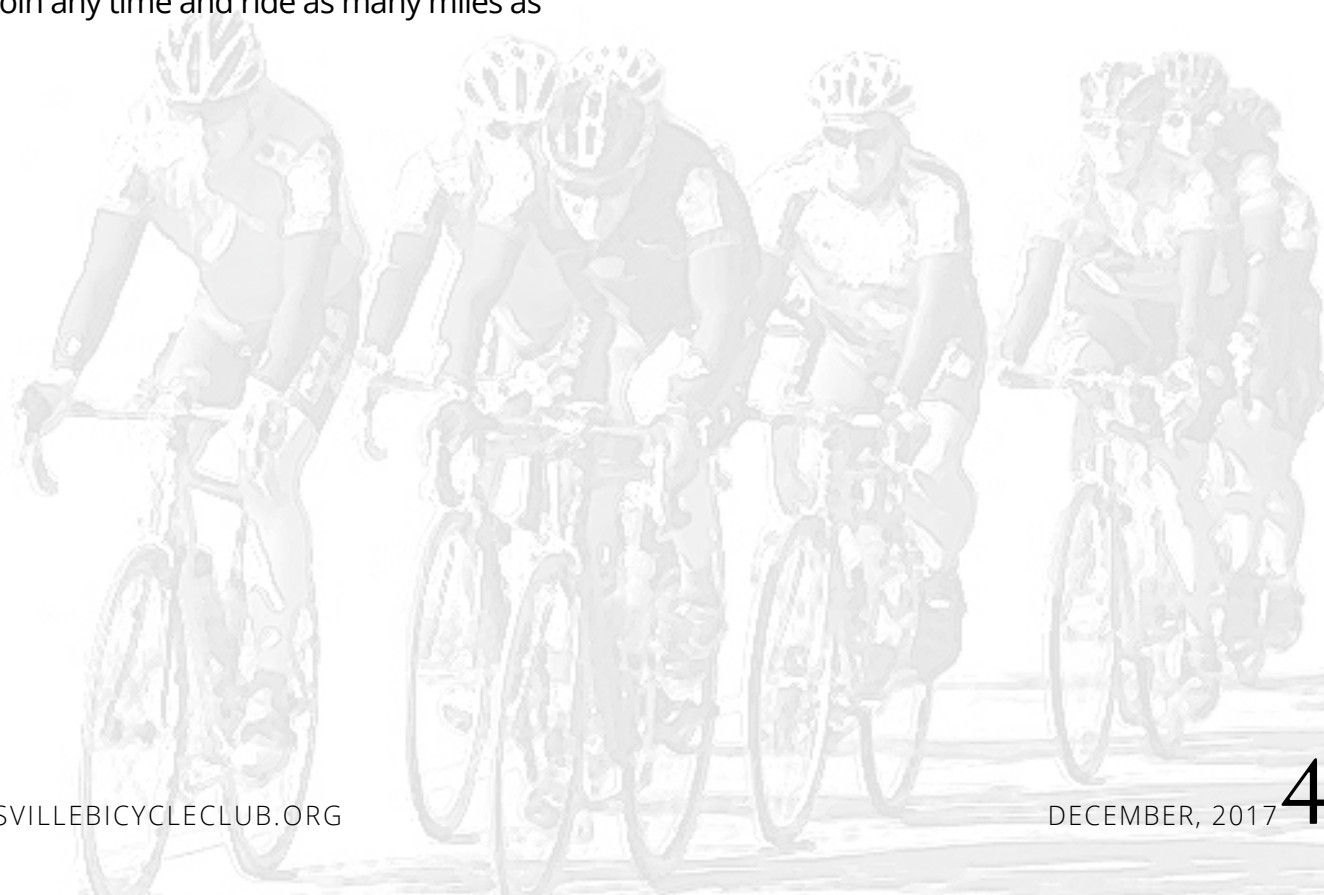
