May is National Bicycle Month

May 14 through May 18 is **Bike to Work Week** with a special focus on Friday May 18 as **Bike to Work Day**.

Notably the Saturday ride is now at Dogtown for the summer with a sprinkling of TDE rides in the morning causing the afternoon ride to move around, the Wednesday night rides are starting at Garvin Park still. We will ride the Greenway when there is no flooding. If you are late we usually start by riding south so come on and join us as we return. All evening rides start at 6:00 pm., with the exception of the Wednesday night ride at the 4-H Center which remains as 5:30 for the extra miles and darkness issues. Sunday afternoons now start at 3:30 pm. Thursday night rides are at Mesker Park this month. This ride starts at 6:00. Please arrive early to line up and hear announcements before leaving with our police escort. Bring all your friends with bicycles. This is a very slow, quiet ride. It is to remember all who have been injured or killed while cycling on public roads.



The cycling events for the Indiana State Senior Games will be held on Sunday, May 20th. This is a qualifying year for the 2019 National Games which will be held in Albuquerque, NM. This is a great way to get your feet wet if you've never raced before, and a challenge if you're an old hand at it. At last year's Nationals, our own Shane Thread walked away with a silver medal in the 10 km time trial.

As we've done for the past several years, we'll have a three race format: 5 km time trial, 10 km time trial and a 20 km road race. Festivities get underway at 8:00 a.m. Headquarters for the cycling events will be at USI. The building is as of now TBD due to the construction project on the MAC. The time trial races will be held on the loop course on the river bottoms roads starting on S. Happe Road near the intersection of Duesner Road. This is assuming the flood damage to these roads has been repaired by that time. The road race will start at the USI softball fields parking lot on Broadway Ave.

Come on out and join the fun. If you're not in to racing, club miles are awarded to all who volunteer as well.
