EBC JULY RIDE NOTES

Gibson County has put down a lot of chip and seal on many of our routes that go into Gibson County. Please be careful on the loose gravel and potential tar on these roads. We did not change the schedule to avoid them yet. It is too extensive.

Also, I keep hearing about a bridge being repaired that will take out some of our longer routes. Again, I am not changing anything as of now but beware that there may be an impassable situation out there somewhere.

There will be a Hosted Ride on July 4! All members are invited to Diane Bies' home for a 26 mile ride at 3:00. (There is a short cut making the route 17 miles if desired.) We will have picnic food at about 4:30 or a little later. Please bring your swim suit to get into the pool and cool down after the ride. Happy Independence Day!

There will also be a Hosted Ride on Friday July 27. This is a moonlight ride. The ride will start and end at the I-69 Access point on Olmstead. Kevin Otolski and Jim Neithammer will lead a no drop ride and provide refreshments after the ride. You must have a light on your bicycle both front and back!

Again, our Saturday rides are all over the place!

Saturday, July 7, we are at Korner Inn in Elberfeld for a 30 mile route with the TDE group also at 9:00. The afternoon ride will be at I-69 Access (Olmstead) at 1:00. This is also the annual Ride to New Albany ride day. You must have your own ride home if you go on this one way ride.

Our July, 14 ride, is the usual Dogtown offering but we start earlier at 8:30 to beat the heat in the morning. That afternoon ride is at 1:00 also from Dogtown Boat Ramp.

July, 21, we are in Dogtown again at both 8:30 and 1:00. This is also the date of RAIN from Terre Haute to Richmond. Hope for positive weather for these participants.

Saturday July 28, the ride is at Henderson County High at both 8:30 and 1:00. This is a beautiful route

well worth the trip across the bridge. Depending where you start from it really isn't any farther than some of our other start points.

Thursday evening rides are at Reitz High School this month and start at the usual 6:00 pm.

ADVOCACY UPDATE

Whether you know it or not, the Evansville Bicycle Club is involved in many cycling projects in Evansville and supports state and national bicycle organizations.

Nationally EBC financially supports the **League of American Bicyclists**.

EBC financially supports the state organization **Bicycle Indiana**

But EBC **SHINES** when it comes to supporting local organizations both financially and physically.

One of these projects is coming up and needs volunteers. Please consider this as a chance to help with something you have a passion for:

RIDING A BICYCLE.

iCan Bike

This program is designed to teach individuals with disabilities or special needs to ride a two wheeled bicycle. The program will accept up to 36 students with each student receiving a special shirt and a helmet.

This year the program will run from Monday, July 9th thru Friday the 13th.

The process begins with the student riding a normal front wheeled bicycle, but the rear wheel is replaced with a set of rollers for stability. The students begin in the Armory gym and ride in circles that are reversed about every fifteen minutes. Each student rides for one hour and fifteen minutes for the five days.

As the student becomes more comfortable and confident, the rollers are changed offering less

stability. By the third day over 50% of the riders will be riding independently on his or her own bicycle and will move outside to the asphalt parking lot. By the end of the fifth day over 80% will be riding independently.

This is where EBC members can assist.

Each child needs an **assistant** that will walk/run beside the child and serve as **"coach"**. It is helpful, but not necessary, if the coach can be that same person each day.

The times for the classes are: 8:00-9:15; 9:25-10:40; 11:00-12:15; 1:00-2:15 and 2:40-3:55.

The other way EBC helps this program is with scholarship assistance (the price for the camp is \$170.00) and actually assisting in purchasing of bicycles.


