
be very refreshing and invigorating, especially in the middle of the week. Some people start early to get a full 20 miles in but feel free to join any time and ride as many miles as you can.

By the OFFICIAL CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS OF THE EVANSVILLE BICYCLE CLUB INC. Revised and approved—January 2013 the following have been contacted by the nominating committee and replied that they are willing to serve on the board of Directors of the Evansville Bicycle Club for calendar year 2019

# Section 1:

The administration of the affairs of the Corporation shall be vested in a Board of Directors and Trustees, referred to here-in as "Board of Directors," composed of not less than seven (7) nor more than ten (10) persons.

# Section 4:

At least thirty (30) days prior to each subsequent annual meeting of the members of the Corporation following the adoption of these By-Laws, the President shall appoint a Nominating Committee consisting of not less than three (3) nor more than five (5) members of the Board of Directors, which committee shall select and designated qualified persons as candidates to fill the vacancies on the Board created by those members whose terms are expiring or who are not wanting to continue in their current position. Additional nominations shall be received from any member of the Corporation at the time of the annual meeting. The candidates receiving a majority of the votes cast at the annual meeting shall be elected to the Board of Directors.

# Section 2:

All officers shall be elected for a term of one (1) year. All officers' terms shall be limited to five (5) consecutive one (1) year terms. After five (5) consecutive one (1) year terms, an officer must step down from that office for at least one (1) year. The officer may, however, be available for election to another office. In any event, no person shall serve more than ten (10) years total lifetime in any one office

# October Evansville Bicycle Club minutes

Meeting was held at Roca Bar on S. Kentucky Ave., Evansville

President Diane Bies opened the meeting at 6:30 pm

August Minutes were handed out to club members present and read by Jeff Lancaster. Paul Jensen 1st the approval and Kevin Otolski 2nd. Minutes were approved as presented.

# Treasurer's report:

Gary Gardner presented and briefly discussed the balance sheet & income spreadsheet and indicated that the majority of the GPM income data was not available at the time of this report. As such, he expected a more thorough accounting of the GPM at the November meeting.

# Membership report:

Via text message from Kara May, EBC has one new member since last month, one renewal and 15 inactive. Total dues paid \$138.

## Website/Facebook:

Jay Vercellotti reported EBC now has 730 Facebook members. The website is down to 171 unique visitors from over 1000 in the past.

### **Old Business:**

Kevin Otolski mentioned that the 2nd Annual winery ride scheduled for October 14 may need to be postponed due to the weather forecast with a high chance of rain and cool temps. Kevin also informed that the proposed joint club ride with Owensboro has been postponed until the spring/summer of 2019 (due to schedule conflicts).

### **New Business:**

Diane Bies announced she would be stepping down from the presidential role at the end of 2018. She also said she would consider being GPM Coordinator as long as there would be a separate Rest Stop Coordinator role. Otolski suggested that we figure out who will be filling all board seats by January 1.

Paul Jensen proposed having four (4) general membership meetings per year at a library or subsidized restaurant, maybe after a ride. These meetings would help promote member involvement and boost preparations/volunteer activities for GPM, with the fourth of such meetings occurring 2 weeks after GPM to discuss results and fine tune improvements for future events. Paul also suggested that we continue talks of EBC-subsidized host rides like we had in the past.

Several members requested that we consider moving the GPM to a Saturday like most other rides do. This change could likely promote overnight trips to Evansville to attend the GPM and allow people to return home before the end of the weekend. It may also allow many church attendees to ride GPM. Several in attendance also liked the idea of adding a 100 mile/century route to GPM.

Paul Jensen presented his latest GPM Retro shirt inventory as of 10-10-18. In summary, 66 of the remaining 453 GPM shirts were sold at the 2018 event. Thus, the current balance of old stock shirts is now 387 (2001 to 2017).
