Everyone take a deep breath, we have gotten through this before we can get through it again. Yes, the fall time change is upon us signaling

for a lot of us the end of after work outdoor rides. For some of you, this is when you go into hibernation and we do not see you again until March.

For the rest of us, it is either lights and warm weather gear or time to ride the indoor trainer. With the advancement in "Smart Trainers"

and software applications, indoor training has become increasingly more enjoyable than say five years ago. A few of the top indoor trainers are the Tacx NEO Smart 2, and the Wahoo Kickr. As far as software goes, I see most people using Zwift or TrainerRoad.

There are some others but these are the two I know the most about. Both offer workout options and training programs for those of you that like to setup your pain cave with high speed fans and 1.21 Gigawatt stereo surround sound system to hammer out some serious workouts. Both also offer just your basic winter base mile rides so you can make sure last year's jersey still fits this spring.

Zwift also allows you to do group rides with other fellow cyclists and friends from the comfort and safety of your pain cave. Whatever option you choose, it sure does make it easier to get on that bike and ride during the winter months. There are quite a

few EBC members doing one of these options so if this is something you are interested in, let me know and I can hook you up with indoor gurus.






























Dear Evansville Bicycle Club:
