positive for the club may have come out of all of this. We are testing an electronic ride signup sheet. You will soon be able to send in your miles from your phone or computer.

We will still accept the paper sign up sheets but

it is my hope most will use the new method. No more cooties by touching the same pen, ride info will get to Rusty sooner and less potential for sheets to get misplaced.
