Hello everyone:

I start this letter off with sad news. On August 16th, fellow EBC member Tom Gabe, pictured below, passed away after a little less than two years battling Acute Myeloid Leukemia. I am not sure how long Tom was an EBC member, but in the anymore and they were not going to be able to get to where they needed to be to have a successful bone marrow transplant and he was coming home. Sixteen days later Tom lost his battle.

Those of you that knew Tom, even though he was a CEO of a



short time I knew him, Tom hosted some EBC club rides from his house and let the EBC use his driveway as a GPM rest stop.

Tom included me on his progress emails that he would send out every now and then. I am not sure how many rounds of chemo he went through but he was trying to get to a point where he could do a bone marrow transplant. Treatments were working for a while and they even had a person that was a bone marrow transplant match, but they had to get to a certain place with the cancer before they could do the transplant. On July 30th, I received my last email from Tom saying the chemo was just not working company and had many other interests and responsibilities, when he was out on his bike he was just one of the guys.

He was alway asking questions of others on what he could do to become a better cyclist. Tom never shied away from doing anything hard. Tom enjoyed cycling which included a lot of miles with Archie Carter and participating in the Leadville Mountain Bike races in Leadville, CO.

When Tom was training for his Leadville events he would sometimes ride with the group that

does a lot of centuries throughout the year.

Tom would always push himself during these rides trying to hang with cyclists half his age. That's the Tom I think a lot of us will remember.

Stay safe, and do hard things.
