"century nonclub mileage" is for any other century credited to a member's century total but not eligible for club miles. Also, we have seen members report miles for just riding an EBC route on any given day. The daily miles must come from the scheduled routes for that day, unless you are doing a special organized event ride. All non century club rides must start +/- 30 minutes of the scheduled start time to count.

I would like to remind you of my hosted Moon Pie ride on July 23rd @ 8:15pm from Olmstead. Route is 17 miles, lights required. Feel free to bring and share some "recovery drinks" with fellow members after the ride.

If you have ever been interested in joining the GPM planning committee, I do have a few co-lead positions open or if you would like to volunteer a little time on the day of the event, please get a hold of me.
