### RAGBRAI — JULY 23-30th

RAGBRAI is the oldest, largest, and longest recreational touring bicycle ride in the world. Started in 1973 by Des Moines Register reporters John Karras and Donald Kaul, RAGBRAI is a seven-day bicycle tour that goes from the Missouri River to the Mississippi River with stops in overnight towns along the way. One of the largest tourism events in the country, a 2008 study by the University of Northern lowa estimates RAGBRAI's economic impact between \$24 million to \$25 million for the weeklong ride. Registration for RAGBRAI XLIX is open at RAGBRAI.com/ragbrai-registration. The full route with meeting and pass thru towns will be announced in March 2022.
