## THE PRESIDENT'S SADDLE

Welcome to July,
Have you ever heard of Unbound Gravel? It's an event comprising gravel racing covering various distances held annually in the Flint Hills region of the Great Plains around Emporia, Kansas. There are several different races but the big ones are the 100 $\mathrm{mi}, 200 \mathrm{mi}$ and the big one called XL which is 350 miles. EBC had some members in the mix last month (June 3-4).

A shout-out needs to go to Brian Lewis who completed the 200 mile race in 14 hours 19 minutes. Another shout-out needs to go to Roger Orth who finished the 350 mile race in 25 hours and 21 minutes. If my information is correct, Roger only stopped for a total of 39 minutes during the entire race. Roger shared his incredible adventure and I thought I would share it with you.

## Unbound XL Update by Roger Orth:

 The south course showcased the beauty of the Flint Hills with the rolling green terrain for as far as the eye could see! The weather at the start of the race and forecast was perfect, not hot and the wind was very manageable.Temps were in the 70's, dipping to

60 overnight with temps on Saturday back in the 70's and the chance of rain was low and diminishing. Due to the great weather (Friday and into Saturday morning) the speed was high and I was estimating that I might finish in under 24 hours which would have been about 4 hours faster than last year on a different course with much different weather.
The course featured many miles in the cattle pins (open range cattle herds) for us to navigate both at day and night. Had a few close calls with black cows standing on the double track "road" during the night just because they were hard to see. The first half of the night included some sketchy sections that required a lot of caution as $3-4$ riders ended up at the ER due to injuries.

Even the gravel roads needed caution as they had hard edges/ groves that were left from car traffic from all the rain Kansas had received in the prior days. The groves would take your front wheel out from you real quick and some of the rocky descents would be fun on a MTN bike.

Personally, I like to ride these roads alone to see my line and not follow wheels. IMO it reduces the risk of

crashing and flats. This makes 2 XL's (700+ miles) with zero flats on my Panaracer Gravelking SK+ tires. I have now made it through the night safely, making great time and heading to my 4th stop to refuel at Yates Center, KS at mile 234. Checking the math in my head and I still believe I can be finished in 24 hours, I end up missing a turn in town so I overreacted, slamming on the breaks to turn around and crash to the pavement on my left side. Instant pain in the shoulder! I checked the collarbone and I think it is still in one piece. I remount the bike while trying to access the damage to the

body and get to Casey's. Refuel with Infinit Custom Blend, take ibuprofen and hit the road again to figure out how to manage the next 120 to Emporia to finish this XL. The shoulder can support some weight but I know I have to be careful and not go down again. Looking north, the weather appears ominous. Dark clouds full of rain but that is the finish-line. I'm back in the cattle pins, I think around mile 295 and the downpour starts with some lightning. No place for cover so I put on the rain jacket and kept pedaling $100 \%$ soaked.

The rain is very cold and the temp is about 60 , l'm injured and riding very
slow now. Now it's about survival or so it seems in my mind and getting to another Casey's in Madison at mile 316. Eventually, I make it there still raining and I just start chugging hot chocolate to warm up and stop shaking. I get back on the bike without even refueling my hydration because the rain has stopped. There are now 4 more XL riders at Casey's and it's only 35 miles home mainly with favorable winds. Time to hammer in the aerobars.

I finished the race! That last 120 miles was the hardest mental and physical challenge on the bike in my life due to the pain from the crash and weather.

So the damage, I did break my left collarbone again. It was already

ugly from a break in 1998 so I had it cleaned up some on Friday with surgery including some bone graft and plate/screws.

My Pactimo bibs and jersey served another crash without ripping even though my shoulder and hip are scratched up. I don't understand how that happens!
My Lauf True Grit that took the beating instead of my body. Just amazing!
Lastly, my supportive, wonderful wife who encourages me in these adventures. She even volunteered over 10 hours at the event this year so I can bypass the lottery next year.

Thanks for sharing your story Roger. I am happy to report Roger is back on the roads and did a century yesterday $(6 / 25)$ with the century group.

Until next month, be careful out there, and watch the intersections as the corn is getting taller.
