For EBC club miles to count, you must start the ride +\- 30 minutes from the scheduled start time. Club centuries must start +\- 60 minutes from the scheduled start time.

Non club mile centuries can start anytime.

You can enter your club miles online at http://www.evansville- **bicycleclub.org/** and click on the submit mileage button.

In club news, watch your email later this month for information on how to order a club or century jersey.

We have just finished up plans for this year's Ride of Silence. I will have more information on this as we get closer to the ride date of May 17th.

MONDAY EVENING RIDES—

at Olmstead are also back. These are only 17 mile rides for this month and will start at 5:30 also. Safety is a concern!
