USI Bike Parks & Trails is a project by Trail Heads - Southwest Indiana, a nonprofit organization with 501(c)3 charitable status. Our current activities for Dubois, Gibson, Spencer, and Warrick counties include after-school group rides, bike maintenance, and trail work. We are currently seeking sponsors for the USI Bike Parks & Trails project.
