## USI BIKE PARKS \& TRAILS

USI Bike Parks \& Trails is a project by Trail Heads - Southwest Indiana, a nonprofit organization with 501 (c) 3 charitable status. Our current activities for Dubois, Gibson, Spencer, and Warrick counties include after-school group rides, bike maintenance, and trail work. We are currently seeking sponsors for the USI Bike Parks \& Trails project.
