#### Hello everyone:



Our monthly club meeting is scheduled for Thursday December 14 at 6:30 at the Turoni's Forget Me Not Inn on Weinbach at Lloyd. This is your club. Please come to the meeting and offer your input. Please come at 6:00 for social time and the meeting to start at 6:30.

**THE CLUB CENTURY** is scheduled for December 7 and 9. We will be doing the Folsomville Route or the Touring Route.

**WEDNESDAY NIGHT RIDES** will all be at Wesselman Park this month due to the Festival of Lights at Garvin Park. This ride is for one hour (6:00 - 7:00 pm) on the very flat road at Wesselman Park. There is minimal traffic. Bring your lights and come well dressed, layers! Riding at night can be very refreshing and invigorating, especially in the middle of the week. Some people start early to get a full 20 miles in but feel free to join any time and ride as many miles as you can.

#### We are trying to schedule a FESTIVAL OF

**LIGHTS RIDE** one Monday, Tuesday or Wednesday evening this month. The cost would be \$4 per person and you can ride your bicycle through Garvin Park and enjoy the light displays. We are still working on scheduling this, hoping to find a warm and dry evening.

## EDITOR'S NOTE ABOUT A LONG STANDING EBC TRADITION:

This information goes out to all my fellow TOSRV (Tour of the Scioto River Valley) participants over the years. I was fortunate to sit in on a ZOOM call with a few Columbus Outdoor Pursuits (COP) Board folks and interested veteran riders across the country in discussing the future of our favorite ride in Central Ohio in September.

Jeff Stephens, one of the COP Directors and a mainstay/director of TOSRV, gave a rather sobering account of how the ride has been losing money and ridership over the years. 2023's Ride only saw appx. 375 two-day riders. Quite a lot less than the numbers Rusty, Gary and I saw the last time we rode together in 2017. (when Sharon, Gene, Keith, Andy, me and a few others attended in the 90's ridership was close to 5,000)

In the call, we discussed several alternatives to keep the ride alive, even including cancelling the ride altogether; a shame considering it is the longest running two-day cycling event in the USA.

The full COP directorship has decided to do the ride one more year in it's current format and then consider changes to keep TOSRV but to change the format, direction, and other alternatives.

For those of you who have ridden and to those who haven't and would like to do it before changes are implemented, put September 21st and 22nd, 2024 on your ride calendar.
