A few years ago, we made a change to make it easier than ever to submit your EBC ride data. Accessible from <u>http://www.evansvillebicycleclub.org/</u>, the form provides quick and easy way to capture all the details of your rides and to get them over to our EBC Statistician, Rusty Yeager. Club members that ride at least 500 schedule club miles and/or complete 10 centuries will get a special recognition at our annual club banquet after the end of the year. I always get a great deal of personal satisfaction when receiving those awards and again, when I see them on the wall in my office, always a reminder to the great times I've had with a great group of people.

Now, despite what one might think, the goal of the EBC is not about racking up miles on the road and handing out awards to our members. I guess it is that in part. But at our core, we are about community and supporting causes/organizations that create more opportunities to not only build the cycling community, but also open doors to folks that might not otherwise be able to experience this life changing activity. Too that end in 2023, the EBC donated a total of \$4,700 to a various organizations to help extend our mission.

Most notably, last year we donated \$1,500 to the Evansville Rehabilitation Center for their annual iCan Bike program, \$1,000 to the USI Bike Parks and Trails project, and \$500 to Evansville Patchwork Central. Again, without our members support, through membership dues and support of the Great Pumpkin Metric, none of that would be possible. I know the club plans on doing more in 2024, so if you are reading this and not a member, please consider joining the EBC.



If you've been a member in the past and are not active, consider jumping back into the club. And, if you know folks that are part of the this amazing community of cyclists in the Evansville area, but might not be aware of the benefits of club membership, encourage them to take a look at what we do and how their membership can help. 
