Then cyclists will be free to ride any or all the designated routes, 36 miles total. There are 4 routes all on paved county roads. The routes extend like a clover leaf, each roughly 9 miles long with mostly right turns. The central trailhead at Boonville-New Harmony and Zoar Church Road intersection has a large sign with the map of the routes. Smaller road signs have been installed on the roads to identify each route by number and color. Please come support this event.
