The first annual **Schweitzer Fest Bicycle Tour** will be held on Sunday, August 12, 2012. It will start at Zoercher-Bettinger Park located on the corner of 10th and Watt Streets in Tell City, Indiana. Choose from four different routes. The 6-mile Family Fun Ride will tour Tell City's various parks and greenways utilizing the new bike lanes in town. The 18 mile ventures out of town to the airport and back.
